"But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them..." 2 Peter 2:1 (NKJV)

During the last 100 years or more, the Christian Church in the Western World has grown complacent, disobedient to Scripture, irrelevant, and accommodating of evil. She lacks the courage to stand up for God's honor and the Bible's Truth to confront evil, injustice and falsehood for fear of losing popularity and financial security.

The International Church Council Project (ICCP)¹, and the Fellowship for International Reformation and Evangelism² have partnered to host the Church Council and Reformation Fire Conference (CCRFC) 2013, "Drawing a Line in the Sand". We are grateful to Crossroads Grace Community Church in Manteca, California for offering their splendid facilities for this conference.

The purpose for this conference, and why we call it "Drawing a Line in the Sand", is that after much prayer and wise counsel, we came to this conclusion: We desperately want God to bless our countries. But we cannot expect a Holy God to bless those who are in rebellion to His Laws. As in the days of the Reformers in the 16th century, we are facing complex internal and external threats:

- Internally we are facing a renaissance of paganism.
- Externally we are facing increasingly aggressive radical Islamic Jihad.
- Our cultures have been hijacked by humanism.
- Theistic Evolution is uncritically accepted.
- The scriptures are twisted to promote a "Health and Wealth" prosperity cult to tell people what they want to hear.
- There is a neglect of prayer, no fear of God, and shocking ignorance of basic Biblical doctrine.
- Christians are ignorant of history and have a very superficial grasp of Scripture.
- Christians are compromising, cowardly and ineffective.
- Christians are in defeat and in retreat in the face of a resurgent paganism, pervasive humanism and Islamic radicalism.
- Christians believe grace frees them from obedience to God's law and salvation is given without consequence for sin.
- Christians believe in egalitarianism between males and females in regard to marriage and ecclesiastical authority.
- Christians believe in an "emergency god" whose only desire is for us to be "good people" in order for us to get to heaven.
- Christians have made it their goal in life to simply be happy and to feel good about themselves.
- Christians are brainwashed through education, worldly entertainment, and deceived by the secular news media.
- Christians, especially in our youth culture, embrace that worldly entertainment, degenerate music, body piercings, and tattoos.
- Churches are filled with weak, worldly, lukewarm and inactive members.
- Churches are increasingly conformed to the world.
- Churches strive to be affirming, popular and non-threatening.
- Churches are neutralized by an eschatology of defeat and retreat, and escapism.
- Churches are self-centered, materialistic, superficial, sensational and self-indulgent.
- Churches have been impacted by the secularization of education, entertainment and the news media.
- Churches are sentimental, trivial, and irrelevant because of pragmatism, consumerism, positive thinking, and materialism.
- Churches are distracted from fulfilling the Great Commission by "Rapture fever" and an "end-times" obsession.
- Instead of the church changing the world, the world is changing the church.

The purpose of CCRFC 2013 - "Drawing a Line in the Sand" is to promote the Church Council Project and to help initiate a New Reformation. Dr. Jay Grimstead and Dr. Peter Hammond have teamed up in this endeavor. In this process they are forming an Advisory Council; a global team of respected Christian leaders and theologians called FIRE (Fellowship for International Reformation & Evangelism). They are asking this FIRE team to commit to helping them accomplish these two goals.

- A) To confront 24 controversial issues in the Church through the Global Church Council scheduled for Wittenberg, Germany in October of 2017 (the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther nailing his 95 Theses to the door.) Their mission statement is "To establish for the 21st century a united, biblical-theological standard of doctrine for the global body of Christ consistent with the mainstream theology of the first 20 centuries." Preceding the Global Church Council, a National Council on Theology will be formed in many countries of the world to discuss the 24 Theological Documents³ created over the past 30 years about these controversial issues. These countries will send delegates to the 2017 Global Church Council and strategize how best to confront and debate those in the Church in their own nations who oppose these 24 Biblical perspectives. We plan to establish "State Councils on Theology" in a number of states in the U.S. who will take on the same action. A new COR book, "Drawing a Line in the Sand", will become available in October of 2013 which features all 24 of these Theological Documents.
- B) To help initiate a New Reformation & Revival among Christian leaders, pastors & teachers with the courage to die for Christ and obey His commands. These "Gideon soldiers" will form "Reformation Teams" to help unify the local Church to honor and obey Jesus as the rightful King of the universe in every area of life. The localized Reformation Teams are to:
 1. Establish 7 Transformational Teams" for strategy and prayer to impact their city and county in these 7 spheres of life:
Business – Government & Law – Media & Arts – Health Care – Education – Family – Church
 2. Launch an Operation Rolling Thunder⁴ around the clock prayer in those regions where 31 churches each commit to 24 hours of prayer for one day each month so systematic prayer is happening locally 24/7 for 365 days each year.
 3. Help courageous pastors form a Pastors Council where those pastors commit to hold their congregations accountable to biblical obedience in all areas of life every day through discipleship to Christian maturity in their own destiny. These Pastors will meet regularly to pray for each other with mutual accountability for living in obedience to the Bible.






Crossroads Grace Community: Intersection of Highways 99/120 at 1505 Moffat Blvd, Manteca CA, 95336



From the North (Sacramento, Stockton)

Take Highway 99 South towards Manteca, Take the Austin Rd Exit.
Turn right at Moffat Blvd and travel ¾ of a mile straight to the Church entrance on right

From the West (Tracy, Livermore, Bay Area, San Francisco)

Take the 580 East to I-205 East, Take I-5 North Ramp to the Highway-120 exit to Manteca/Sonora
Take the Hwy-99 S ramp to Modesto/Fresno/Los Angeles, Take the Austin Rd exit
Turn right at Moffat Blvd and travel ¾ of a mile straight to the Church entrance on right

From the South (Modesto, Fresno, Bakersfield, Los Angeles)

Take Highway 99 North towards Manteca, Take the Austin Rd Exit, Turn left at S. Austin Rd
Turn right at Moffat Blvd and travel ¾ of a mile straight to the Church entrance on right

NOTE: For Food, Lodging, Fuel and Shopping, turn right from the church parking lot headed north on Moffat Blvd for about ½ mile. Turn right on Spreckles Ave. Continue towards Yosemite Blvd. Starbucks, In-N-Out, Panda Express, Chipotle, Holiday Inn Express, etc. are to the right. 
